

Crabtree Swim and Tennis Rules and Regulations

General Rules

- 1. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The Club assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use.**
2. Members and their guests must sign in on the registration book located in front of the Snack Bar upon arrival.
3. For everyone's safety, glass, glass bottles, and glass food containers are not permitted at any time within the fenced pool enclosure.
4. No smoking is allowed within fenced pool enclosure.
5. All lounge chairs and tables are to be used on a first-come, first-served basis.
6. Toys/Riding devices with wheels, including (but not limited to) bikes and wagons are NOT permitted ANYWHERE within the fenced pool enclosure.
7. The stereo volume must be kept at a REASONABLE level. (Members are encouraged to use personal audio devices with headphones or earpieces)
8. NO children under 11 years of age shall be left at the pool without direct supervision of a responsible person.
9. Adults shall be responsible for children using the baby pool and play area.
10. No pets are allowed within the fenced pool enclosure.
11. Sand from the volleyball court MUST be rinsed off using the outside shower BEFORE entering the pool area.
12. Every member and guest is expected to cooperate to keep the pool premises clean and attractive and free of debris.
13. The pool Board of Directors reserves the right to suspend any member.

Pool Rules

1. No one will use the pool unless there is an employed lifeguard on duty.
2. There will be a ten-minute break each hour. All persons under the age of 18 will be required to get out of the water during this break.

3. No horse play, dunking, running, boisterous or rough play shall be allowed in or around the pool, and violators will be subject to discipline by the attending lifeguard. Repeated violations shall be grounds for suspension.
4. Swimmers **MUST** stay off lap lanes, ropes, safety lines and lifeguard stands.

5. Please refrain from distracting the lifeguards while on duty – they are here for your safety.
6. Infants must wear “swim” diapers in the baby pool or regular pool.
7. No kids **OVER** 6 years old are allowed to swim in the baby pool.
8. **Diving Board Rules:**
 - a. Board closure and opening is controlled by the lifeguard.
 - b. One person allowed on diving board at a time
 - c. Diver may bounce once on the board, no multiple bounces
 - d. Divers must go **straight off** the board to the middle of the deep end – not to either side of the deep end.
 - e. Upon completion of a dive, swim to the closet ladder.
 - f. Next diver **MUST WAIT** until last diver has reached the side of the pool **BEFORE** attempting to use the board.
 - g. No jumping on others from the diving board.

9. Lifeguards shall be on duty at all times during pool hours. Their first duty shall be safety and they will be responsible for enforcing the pool rules.
Parents, however, are expected to personally supervise their children, and the responsibility of adults who accompany children to the pool does not cease because a lifeguard is on duty. All persons with children in their care are required to watch, protect, supervise, and control these children at all times when they are on Club property.

Guests and Fees

1. All guests **MUST** be accompanied by a member. There is no fee for out-of-county guests. Wake County guests must pay \$5 per person when they enter. Pay the

lifeguard if you are not sure of where to put the guest fees. (**Note:** There is a separate cash box in the snack bar for guest fees.) If a child is accompanied by a babysitter instead of a parent, the non-member babysitter does not have to pay. However, if a member babysitter brings a non-member child to the pool, a \$5 fee must be paid for that child. (The lifeguards should be given up-to-date membership lists to be kept in the guardroom so they have some leverage/info especially when dealing with non-members who come in alone.)

Pool/Birthday Parties Rules and Fees

1. All usage of the Crabtree Swim and Tennis Club by any group must be approved and paid for in advance.
2. Reservations for parties (Birthday, Office, Church, Scout Groups, etc.) will be handled by the Pool Manager. (Note – Person making reservation MUST be member of the club and be PRESENT at the event)

Fee for Pool Private Parties

- \$ 75.00 per hour for parties 8 pm – 11 pm
- \$ 15.00 per hour for each lifeguard. Parties over 15 people will require more than one lifeguard. Parties with alcohol require an extra guard regardless of number of guests, and must have board approval first.
- Private parties must be held after pool hours

Fee for Kid's Birthday Parties (15 people or less):

- \$ 40.00 Fee. Picnic Tables are first-come, first-served.
- Please limit parties to two hours. Maximum 15 people per party.
- Set up time no more than one hour prior to party
- Member is responsible for thoroughly cleaning after the party.
- Parties are not allowed on Saturday or Sunday unless they occur before or after pool hours. (**Note: Parties during this time that**

intend to use the pool will require a \$15.00 per hour Lifeguard Fee in addition to the \$40.00 fee)

Clubs and Organization Rentals (Boy scouts, Church groups...)

- Monday – Thursday Only (8:00 pm to 11:00 pm)
- \$ 40.00 Fee (for Parties of 15 or less) plus \$15.00 per hour for lifeguard
- \$75.00 Fee (for Parties of 15 or more) plus \$30.00 per hour for two lifeguards.

Snack Bar Rules

1. The Snack Bar is provided as a convenience for members. Failure to adhere to the Snack Bar Rules will result in closing of the Snack Bar.
2. It is not the lifeguard's responsibility to monitor the Snack Bar. The Snack Bar is member-run on an Honor System.
3. Punch Cards are available for purchase for \$5, \$10, and \$20.
4. You must pay for all food and drink at the time of purchase.
5. Cash goes in the cash box below the Snack Bar window. "Punch Cards" are in the index box with the hole-puncher.
6. Only those 17 years and older are allowed in the Snack Bar. If you are under 17, please seek the assistance from someone 17 or older.
7. MICROWAVE USE: A plate must be used when cooking.
8. REFRIDGERATOR/FREEZER USE: The refrigerator is available for use on a daily basis. Please remove your belongings when you leave the pool for the day. The stand-alone freezer is NOT available for personal use.
9. **The refrigerator will be emptied every Monday evening. Anything left, aside from candy and drinks for sale, will be thrown away.**
10. Each person is responsible for cleaning all spills in the microwave, refrigerator, freezer, counters and floor that they cause.
11. All trash must be disposed of properly.
